The Legacy of the National Black Law Students Association

In 1968, on the campus of New York University School of Law, Algernon Johnson (“A.J.”) Cooper responded to the need for continued educational encouragement, professional development and community enrichment for Black law students. Mr. Cooper founded the National Black Law Students Association, a 501(c)(3) organization, which currently serves nearly 6,000 student members worldwide.

Today, we face a great milestone in the history of this organization as we celebrate 50 YEARS of service, advocacy and leadership. Since its inception, NBLSA has been a valuable resource in addressing the educational needs and goals of minority law students, while encouraging their professional advancement and fostering meaningful relationships with Black attorneys and other legal professionals.
